

All of our learning this half term is themed around our topic of Food and Farm.



Focus area: Independence and Self Help and Preparation for Adulthood (Life Skills)

We will learn about keeping our bodies healthy through the benefits of exercise. We will be learning which foods which are good for us, then shopping for ingredients and preparing healthy snacks We will be working on our individual life skills targets during Ready for Writing interventions.

Focus area: Communication and Interaction

We will learn about how to communicate by listening and answering questions, like 'who?' and 'where?'. We will have daily Talk Time and develop our skills of talking with our friends. We will be working on our individual communication and interaction targets during Talk Boost interventions.



Focus area: Social, Emotional Wellbeing and Mental Health

We will learn about our feelings and how to regulate our feelings, including using Zones of Regulation. We will think about how we are a good friend to our classmates and how we can be kind towards others.

In the complementary areas of our curriculum (understanding the world, expressive arts and design, sensory and physical development, mathematics, literacy and RE) some of the tasks we will do are:

- Some of the books we will be reading are Farmyard Hullabaloo, The Little Red Hen, I love Animals.
- We will be tasting fruit from around the world and learning about where eggs and milk come from.
- We will be visiting a farm and experiencing the sights, sounds and smells of the farm.
- We will be creating pictures and models of farm animals.
- We will be practicing our running, jumping and sports days skills.
- We will be thinking about Special Food for celebrations for RE.
