

In Maths our topics will be ‘Take and Give 1,2,3’ and ‘Talk about Dots’

We will be learning how to:

- Recognise numbers to 5
- Carefully count a group of objects and know how many there are altogether
- Compare and sort collections
- Begin to subitise 1, 2, 3
- Explore patterns in art

In Communication and Language our focus is oracy – the ability to express yourself clearly and communicate with others effectively through spoken language. We will focus on the language of sequencing.

e.g.

First, we.....	Next, we.....	Then,
we.....	After that, we.....	Before we....., we need
to.....	Finally.....	In the end,happens.

In Literacy our texts will be The Hungry Caterpillar, Avocado Baby, We’re Going on a Bear Hunt, Jasper’s Beanstalk, Five Minutes Peace

- While reading these we will learn about story structure, focusing on being able to talk about and sequence main events in stories.
- In phonics, we will focus on alliteration and oral blending
- When writing we will talk about marks made, join in with Pen Disco and focus on name writing.

In Nursery, our topic for Spring 2 is ‘Growing’. Our learning is through a blended and integrated approach using our themed curriculum as well as being informed by children’s interests.



In Understanding the World our focus is Growing and changes

We will be learning about:

- Sequence how we have changed from since we were babies
- Springtime
- How plants grow and what helps them to grow
- Lifecycles of butterflies
- Planting seeds and caring for them

In PSED our puzzle is Healthy Me.

We learn about our bodies: the names of some key parts as well as how to stay healthy. We talk about food and that some foods are healthier than others. We discuss the importance of sleep and what we can do to help ourselves get to sleep. We talk about hand washing and why it is important. The class also discuss ‘stranger danger’ and what we should do if approached by someone we don’t know.

In PE our topic is dance (simple sequencing of movements) and development of our gross motor skills.

In Expressive Arts and Design our focus is printing and exploring patterns through:

- Finger/hand printing
- Use kitchen utensils to print with
- Food printing
- Lego printing
- Pen Disco
- In music, copying simple sequences
