

In Maths we will be learning how to:

- Show how to make 5.
- Count groups of objects accurately.
- Share objects equally into 2 or 3 groups.
- Make our own repeating patterns. Spot mistakes in patterns and correct them. Match, sort and compare amounts.
- Recognise and form some numbers correctly.

In Literacy our texts, Silly Jack, The Enormous Turnip, Rosie's Walk, Tree: Seasons Come and Seasons Go, Stuck in the Mud and Duck in a Truck

- While reading these we will learn how to hold extended conversations about stories.
- In phonics, we will focus on oral blending and segmenting and begin to learn the Read Write Inc Set 1 sounds.
- We will be taking part in Drawing Club, where they will begin to record the sounds we hear in words and understand we write for a purpose.

In Understanding the World our focus is Weather and Seasons:

- We will learn about the weather and how it affects us and our planet.
- We will learn about the different seasons and seasonal changes
- We will continue to plant seasonal flowers and watch them grow and observe changes.
- We will be learning about occupations, in particular a farmer and exploring what they do.
- Our visit to Deen City Farm will help us to learn all about farm animals.



In Nursery, our topic for Summer 2 is 'The World Around Me'. Our learning is through a blended and integrated approach using our themed curriculum as well as being informed by children's interests.

In PSED our puzzle is Changing Me.

We will learn about how we have changed from being a baby and what may change for us in the future. We consolidate the names and functions of some of the main parts of the body and discuss how these have changed. We learn that our bodies change in lots of different ways as we get older. We begin to understand that change can bring about positive and negative feelings, and that sharing these can help.

In Expressive Arts and Design:

- We will use our imagination in art and music.
- We will learn how to draw a person and express emotion in the drawing.
- We will sing in a high and low pitch and voice match.
- We will be playing instruments to music and performing to our friends.

In Communication and Language our focus is oracy – the ability to express yourself clearly and communicate with others effectively through spoken language. We will focus on the language of explanation.

e.g.
It is..... It's the same/different I noticed that... I think this happens because.... It changes when It is sunny / raining because..... We wear hats in the summer because..... We wear coats in winter because....

In PE our topic is team games

Our PE days this half term is **Thursday**. In Physical Development we will continue to develop our fine and gross motor skills. Our focus will be improving pencil grip for writing.
