Where: Autumn Walk in Local Woods
When: Autumn Term 2

We will be taking a short walk to our local woods in our wellies and warm coats. We will be looking very closely as we walk and we will talk to our partners about what we see. What can we see and smell? Can we find anything interesting on the floor to share with our friends when we return to nursery? What do the trees look like? Is it easy to walk in the mud?
 All our finds from the walk will form a page in our floor book, along with photos of the trip, so that we can share them with our friends and talk about our shared experience.



Where: Deen City Farm
When: Summer Term 2

Our Summer 2 topic is 'Do Cows Drink Milk?' As part of this topic will be visiting Deen City Farm in Merton, near Wimbledon. This will enable the children to see, feel and smell many of the farm animals we will be studying as part of our topic. We will experience a ride on the tram to the Morden Road stop and then have a short walk to this urban farm. We will explore the farm at our own leisure using the animal signs as a teaching aid. The children will be able feed some of the animals, getting a much closer experience with a variety of farm animals. After we have finished exploring the farm and meeting the animals we will all eat our packed lunches together before returning on the tram.



Where: Spring Walk in Local Woods
When: Spring Term 2

In the Spring term will be repeating our wood walk we went on in the Autumn term. We will be thinking about the changes that have taken place. What do the trees look like now? Can we see any flowers now or blossom? Does it seem the same as when we last visited? Are there any other changes can you see?
 This trip has many links to the early years' curriculum, especially Understanding The World :
 - Use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials.
 - Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary.
 - Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment.
