

In Maths we will be learning how to:

- Count groups of objects accurately.
- Share objects equally into 2 or 3 groups.
- Make our own repeating patterns. Spot mistakes in patterns and correct them.
- Recognise and form some numbers correctly.

In Communication and Language our focus is Oracy and the language of Hypothesis – a suggestion that tries to explain something based on evidence.

e.g.
It is.... because /I think because
It will because /The is because

We will be developing our vocabulary related to our topic.

In Literacy our texts will be Rosie’s Walk, The Enormous Turnip, Tremendous Tractors, Stuck in the Mud and Duck in a Truck

- While reading these we will learn how to use our growing phonic knowledge to read simple words.
- We will be retelling the stories, using the story language.
- We will be introducing the children to Drawing Club, where they will begin to record the sounds they hear in words.

In Nursey, our topic for Summer 2 is 'Do cows drink milk?'. Our learning is through a blended and integrated approach using our themed curriculum as well as being informed by children’s interests.



In Understanding the World:

- We will learn about the weather and how it affects us and our planet.
- We will continue to plant seasonal flowers and watch them grow and observe changes.
- We will be learning about occupations, in particular a farmer and exploring what he does.
- Our trip to Deen City Farm will help us to learn all about farm animals.

In PSED our puzzle is Changing Me.

We will learn about how we have changed from being a baby and what may change for us in the future. We consolidate the names and functions of some of the main parts of the body and discuss how these have changed. We learn that our bodies change in lots of different ways as we get older. We begin to understand that change can bring about positive and negative feelings, and that sharing these can help.

In Expressive Arts and Design:

- We will learn how to draw a person and express emotion in the drawing.
- We will be playing instruments to music and performing to our friends.

In PE our topic is team games and we will be preparing for sports day.

Our PE days this half term is Wednesday. In Physical Development we will continue to develop our fine and gross motor skills. Our focus we will be improving pencil grip for writing.
