

## Quest Primary School Trips and Excursions

### Reception - Overview for Parents & Carers

Where: **Selsdon Library**  
When: **Autumn Term 2**



This trip links to our focus on Reading for Pleasure and enjoying sharing and listening to stories. At the library, the librarians talk to children about what a library is and how they can join. They are then given some time to browse. When we return to school, we discuss the different types of books we saw in the library and what our favourite books were. The children will take home a leaflet informing parents of how to join Selsdon Library.

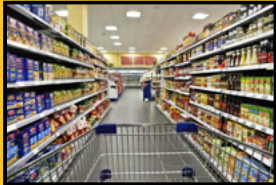


Where: **Transport trip to the Park**  
When: **Summer Term 1**

In Summer 1 our topic is 'Are we there yet?' We will be reading several transport themed stories in our Drawing Club sessions such as 'You Can't Take an Elephant on a Bus', 'Meg's Car' and 'The Train Ride'. As a class we will be going on a trip to the park and using two methods of public transport to get there and back. We will get there via bus, and back to school via tram so the children can experience some of the modes of transport from our stories.

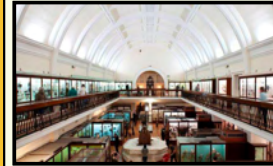


Where: **Supermarket trip**  
When: **Spring Term 1**



In Spring 1 our topic is 'Are carrots orange?' We will be taking a trip to the supermarket to take photographs and collect a rainbow of healthy foods. After we will be able to use our senses to investigate the foods and even taste things we've never tried before! We will have read about lots of these fruits and vegetables in our Drawing Club stories this term. Following the visit, we'll use different skills to chop, mash and peel a range of vegetables to make a delicious soup to share. We will then be able to turn our class role play into our own farm shop, filled with lots of the healthy food we have seen.

Where: **Horniman Aquarium**  
When: **Summer Term 2**



In Summer 2 our topic is 'Who lives in a rock pool?' We will be reading a mix of non-fiction and fiction books about sea creatures to learn all about them. We will take our investigation skills one step further by visiting a real aquarium to find some of the creatures we have been learning about. We will also be learning about the environment, litter and what it does to our eco-system.
