

Reception Curriculum Insight – Summer Term 2

In Maths we will be learning how to:

- Build numbers beyond 9 (10-20)
- Continue patterns beyond 10
- Verbally count beyond 20
- Verbally count patterns
- Compose, decompose and manipulate shapes
- Find 2D shapes within 3D shapes

In Literacy our texts will be:

- Billy's Bucket
- Shark in the Park!
- The Storm Whale
- Under the Sea
- Lost and Found
- Only One You

While reading these we will learn how to write setting descriptions, create posters and write information booklets from non-fiction texts.

In Understanding the World

We will learn about:

- Different occupations (now and in the past)
- Our learning journey and the growing we have done together
- Recycling
- Keeping a growing diary to make observations and draw plants



In Reception, our topic for Summer 2 is 'Who lives in a rock pool?' Our learning is through a blended and integrated approach using our themed curriculum as well as being informed by children's interests.

In Communication and Language our focus is Oracy and the language of Hypothesis – a suggestion that tries to explain something based on evidence.

e.g.

It is.... because I think because It will because The is because

Expressive Arts and Design our focus is expressing emotions.

We will look at different emotions, taking photographic portraits and recreating these with different mediums.

In PSED our puzzle is Changing Me.

We will learn about how we have changed from being a baby and what may change for us in the future. We consolidate the names and functions of some of the main parts of the body and discuss how these have changed. We learn that our bodies change in lots of different ways as we get older. We begin to understand that change can bring about positive and negative feelings, and that sharing these can help.

In Physical Development our focus is sending and receiving.

We will also consolidate all skills learnt in preparation for Sports Day. Our PE day this half term is Wednesday.
