

In maths we will be learning how to:

- Count in 2s, 5s, and 10s
- Recognise and make equal groups
- Make equal groups by grouping and sharing
- Make doubles
- Find half of an object or shape
- Find a quarter of an object or shape
- Find half and a quarter of quantities
- Describe position using left, right, forwards, backwards, above and below
- Use ordinal numbers (1st/2nd/ 3rd etc) to represent position

In Science our topic is Plants

We will learn about the conditions plants need to grow (light, water, air, nutrients and the correct temperature). We will name garden and wildflowers, and label parts of trees. We will label the parts of a plant and discuss the different uses of plants.

In English our texts will be Lost and Found and Pig the Pug

While reading these we will learn how to write a non-chronological report using statements, extended paragraphs and question marks. We will write poetry and write in the role of a character.



In PSHE our puzzle is Relationships.

We will learn about different types of families. We will discuss what it means to be a good friend and appropriate ways to greet friends. We will talk about our qualities as a person and as a friend and who is special to us.

In art our topic is Collage

- We will explore a range of different techniques to create a mixed media collage in the style of Henri Rousseau.

In geography our topic is UK weather, the Poles and the Equator

We will learn to locate, name and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas. We will use geographical vocabulary to refer to the physical and human features of the United Kingdom and its countries. We will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the equator.



In RE our topic is 'How did the universe come to be?'

- We will learn about the creation story for Christians and Hindus. We will learn about what it means to be a Christian and a Hindu and discuss how holy books help us understand what people believe.

In PE our topic is Run, Jump, Throw
