

In maths we will be learning how to:

- Finish length and perimeter
- Compare and order unit fractions
- Compare and order non-unit fractions
- Equivalent fractions on a number line
- Simple equivalent fractions

In science our topic is Forces and Magnets

We will learn about gravity, friction, air resistance and push and pull forces.

Children will complete some experiments to see the effects of different forces.

We will explore which materials are magnetic and which are not.

**In English our texts will be Cloud Tea
Monkeys and Pied Piper of Hamelin**

- While reading these we will learn how to write non-chronological reports, how Tea is made around the world and how to use imperative verbs.
- We will also use Traditional Tales as inspiration to write our own stories.

In PSHE our puzzle is Healthy Me.

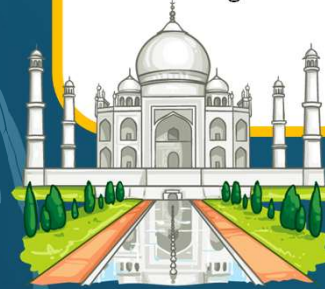
We will learn about setting ourselves a fitness challenge and making healthy choices.

In DT our topic is Seasonal Food

- We will learn how to cook seasonal food safely. The children will try different fruits and vegetables, They will explore how seasonality has affected food production and will cook some small meals.

In Geography our topic is India

We will learn about Indian culture, climate, mountains, climate change and its impacts, rivers and their features, the Himalayas, and the religious and cultural importance of the Gangees.
