

In maths we will be learning about:

- Area
What area is, making shapes with a focus on area and comparing areas
- Multiplication and Division
The 3, 6, 9, 7, 11 and 12 times table including division facts, multiplying three numbers together, dividing numbers by 1 and itself, multiplying by 0

In PE our topic is Gymnastics.

Our PE days this half term are Monday and Tuesday

In science our topic is Animals including Humans

We will learn about what human teeth look like and what happens if we do not look after them, the different teeth of animals and what they are used for, what makes up our digestive system and how it works.

In English our texts will be FArTHER and Until I Met Dudley

- While reading these we will learn how to write recounts, retellings, diary entries, sequels, explanatory posters, letters and explanations amongst others
- We will be using technical vocabulary, modal verbs, expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, personification, relative clauses, multi-clause sentences and other elements

In PSHE our puzzle is Celebrating Difference

We will learn about how to try and accept people for who they are and how it might feel to be a witness to bullying.

In Music we will have whole-class instrumental tuition from Croydon Music Association. We will be continuing to learn how to play the violin and parents will be invited to come and join our concert at the end of term.

In DT our topic is Storybook Mechanisms

- We will learn how to create different mechanisms such as levers, pivots, linkages and more, we will investigate different books with moving parts before planning and creating our own page from a familiar tale.

In Geography our topic is Italy



We will learn how to use maps with a 4-figure grid reference, identify the location of Italy and how this impacts the climate, comparing different regions of Italy, how tourism affects Italy, the layers of the earth, how volcanoes are formed, the stages of an eruption and to classify volcanoes and look at geothermal energy.

In RE our question is: How do people express commitment to religion in different ways?

- We will learn about how we show commitment, how Christians, Jews and Muslims show commitment to their faith and the importance of commitment ceremonies.
- We will also cover the Christmas story and its importance

In Latin (KS2) our topic is Food Glorious Food

- We will learn about Roman dinner parties, noun and adjective agreements and the rooms in a Roman house. We will continue to develop our translation skills and will look at another myth as part of this.
