

**In maths we will be learning about:**

- Place Value  
How to represent numbers to 10,000, partitioning numbers to 10,000, comparing and ordering numbers to 10,000, rounding numbers to 10,000 and Roman Numerals
- Addition and Subtraction  
adding and subtracting two 4 digit numbers with exchanging in the formal written method, estimating and choosing effective strategies

**In English our texts will be Tar Beach and Varmints**

- While reading these we will learn how to describe settings, write a formal letter, script, diary entry, write instructions and speeches and write an explanation text.
- We will be using noun phrases, difference sentence types, prefixes and suffixes, conjunctions, prepositional phrases, imperative verbs, commas for clauses and other elements.

**In history our topic is The Romans**

We will learn about the Roman invasion and why they decided to invade Britain, why the Roman army was successful and the soldiers in the army, how life changed after the Romans invaded and the reaction of Celtic tribes, the religious beliefs of the Romans and comparing the Romans to the Ancient Egyptians.



**In computing our topic is The Internet**

We will learn about networks, why it is important to keep these networks secure, the World Wide Web being part of the internet and exploring it, who owns content and what can be created, added and accessed, as well as evaluating online content to decide how honest accurate and reliable it is.



**In PSHE our puzzle is Being Me in My World**

We will learn about how it might feel to be included and excluded from a group and how we can make others feel welcome and valued.

**In Music** we will have whole-class instrumental tuition from Croydon Music Association. We will be learning to play the violin.

**In science our topic is Sound**

We will learn about what sound is and how it is made, how sound travels, how we hear, how a sound changes volume and pitch and have a go at making our own musical instruments.



**In art our topic is Drawing the Human Figure**

- We will explore the human figure in it through paintings and sculptures, how to draw the human figure, create sketches of the human figure in different positions and create a Modroc sculpture
