

In maths we will be learning how to:

- Decimals
Continuing our work on making a whole with tenths and hundredths, partitioning decimals, comparing and ordering decimals, rounding to the nearest whole number and understanding halves and quarters as decimals.
- Money
Writing money as decimals, converting between pounds and pence, comparing, estimating and calculating problems involving money
- Time
Converting between the analogue and digital times, converting from and to the 24 hour clock.

In English our texts will be The Baker by The Sea and The Matchbox Diary

- While reading these we will learn how to write postcards, dialogue, setting descriptions, informal letters, diary entries, adverts, writing our own fantasy story sequel and our own version of a fable.
- We will be using, inverted commas for speech, noun phrases with preposition, paragraphs to organise our writing, contrasting conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and writing in the present perfect tense.



In PSHE our puzzle is Healthy Me.

We will learn about how we feel about our friendship groups and how friendships can impact us and who we want to be friends with.

In Music we will have whole-class instrumental tuition from Croydon Music Association. We will be continuing to learn how to play the violin and parents will be invited to come and join our concert at the end of term.

In art our topic is Observational drawings

- We will learn why Ancient pottery is important to the artworld.
- How Greek pottery has been used in storytelling and depicting the human form.
- The different techniques to add tone to realistic drawings.

In history our topic is Ancient Greece

We will learn about the location of Ancient Greece, similarities between Athens, Sparta and Rome, to understand women's roles in Ancient Greek society, to understand the significance of Greek democracy on our lives today, to understand the Spartan way of life, to understand the religious beliefs of Ancient Greece including the Olympic Games, to know information about the Greek Gods- comparing beliefs about the afterlife and to understand how our lives today have been affected by the Ancient Greeks.

In Latin (KS2) our topic is Romans and Britons

- We will learn about:
- The inventions that Rome brought to Britain
- The different tribes which inhabited Britain before
- Look at adverbs in Latin
- Learn an ancient British tale called 'A Traveller's Tale'

In PE our topic is Net and Wall Games.
