

In maths we will be learning about:

- Shape
classifying shapes, comparing and ordering angles as well as identifying lines of symmetry
- Statistics
understand and use simple scales and interpret charts including bar charts, pictograms and line graphs
- Position and Direction
using coordinates and translations on a grid.

In science our topic is Living Things and Their Habitats

We will learn about:

- Living things,
- Habitats,
- Food chains and food webs
- Vertebrates and invertebrates
- Classification keys
- Environment changes and climate change

In English our texts will be ‘The Story of Tutankhamun’ and ‘Granny Came Here on the Empire Windrush’

- While reading these we will learn how to write reports, instructions, character descriptions, diaries informal letters and factual reports.
- We will be using fronted adverbials, writing in paragraphs, using apostrophes, commas to create complex sentences and noun phrases as well as other elements.

In PSHE our puzzle is Changing Me.

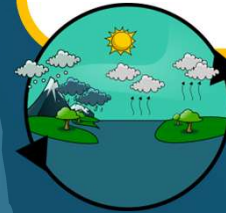
We will learn about the physical and emotional changes I may experience during puberty.

In art our topic is Painting in the style of Jan Aranyi

- We will learn how to show texture and tone through hatching and crosshatching
- We will look at primary and secondary colours with a focus on warm, cool and contrasting colours
- Using different techniques such as line, pattern and tone to create effects

In geography our topic is a UK Comparison between The Lake District and Dover

We will learn about the water cycle, Dover as a town and its features, renewable/non-renewable energy including wind farming and topography. We will compare this with The Lake District and consider how tourism impacts the area.

- How the Creation story affects Christian responses to the environment
- What everyone believes about creation and what Christians can learn from the Creation story
