

In maths we will be learning how to:

- Find equivalents of unit and non-unit fractions
- Convert improper fractions to mixed numbers
- Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator

It is imperative children know their times tables and division facts.

In science our topic is Forces.

We will learn about push, pull and twist as different forces. We will study gravity and the impact of friction, air resistance and water resistance on an object.

In English our texts will be Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo and The Man Who Walked Between the Towers by Mordicai Gerstein.

While reading these we will learn how to

- Use expanded noun phrases
- Use modal verbs to indicate degrees of possibility
- Use brackets, commas or dashes for parenthesis

In PSHE our puzzle is Celebrating Difference

We will learn about different cultures in our local and global communities. We will discuss how we treat others, and how we can respond if we see others being treated unfairly.

In DT our topic is Mechanisms: moving toys

We will learn investigate and research toys with different cams mechanisms, and different ways of strengthening a moving toy. We will then design and create our own moving toys!

In history, we are continuing to study the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

We will learn about why the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings may have invaded and settled in the United Kingdom, and study some of the ways this influenced Britain. We will examine the influence and impact the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings had on religion in Britain, as well as studying historical evidence found at the Sutton Hoo burial site to determine what else we can learn from life at that time.



In RE our topic is Christianity.

We will learn about Easter and the resurrection and why it is important to Christians. We will learn about and discuss the significance and of Good Friday and Easter Sunday in the Christian faith.
