

In maths we will be learning about Place Value, and Addition and Subtraction including:

- Reading and writing numbers to 1,000,000
- Comparing and ordering numbers to 1,000,00
- Rounding to the nearest 10,100 and 1,000
- Adding and subtracting whole numbers with more than 5 digits
- Solving multi-step problems using addition and subtraction

In science our topic is Properties and Changes of Materials

We will learn about the properties of different materials, and which properties make good conductors. Will we study which materials are soluble and insoluble, as well as investigate reversible and irreversible changes of state.

In English, our texts will be The Lost Thing by Shaun Tan and Freedom Bird by Jerdine Nolen

While reading these we will learn how to

- Use adverbials of time, manner and place
- Use ambitious adjectives to create noun phrases
- Use relative pronouns to create relative clauses

In PSHE our puzzle is Being Me in My World

We will learn about being a citizen, the responsibilities we have, rewards and consequences, and setting our class learning charter for the year ahead!

In art our topic is Comparing Portraiture

- We will study the work of Hans Holbein and examine what his artwork tells us about the people he painted.
- We will also study portraits from Expressionist and contemporary artists before creating our own self portraits

In history our topic is Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

We will learn about why the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings may have invaded and settled in the United Kingdom, and study some of the ways this influenced Britain. We will examine the influence and impact the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings had on religion in Britain, as well as studying historical evidence found at the Sutton Hoo burial site to determine what else we can learn from life at that time.



In Latin (KS2) our topic 'The Best Days of Your Life'

We will learn about school and education in the Roman times, and the games children played.

We will also revise the use of verbs, adjectives and nouns.

We will look at the myth of Narcissus and Echo.

In PE our topic is Invasion Games.
