

**In maths we will be learning how to:**

- Calculate the perimeter and area of rectilinear and compound shapes
- drawing, reading and interpreting line graphs
- reading two-way tables such as bus and train timetables
- identifying, measuring and calculating angles

**In science computing our topic is Living Things and Habitats**

We will learn about the life cycle of different animals and plants, sexual and asexual reproduction of animals and plants, and study metamorphosis in class.

**In English, we will write a prequel to *The Lost Happy Endings* by Carol Ann Duffy. We will also write a short non-chronological report about the Titanic. We will:**

- Use brackets and dashes for parenthesis
- Use relative clauses, selecting the appropriate relative pronoun
- Use a range of figurative language to describe settings and character

**In PSHE our puzzle is Relationships.**

We will learn about how to engage with online games and communities safely, and who to protect ourselves when we are using the internet.

**In Art our topic is Still Life.**

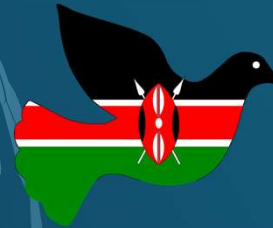
- We will learn how to create 2D and 3D shapes using shading and tone, inspired by the work of Cezanne.

**In PE our topic is Swimming**

We will be swimming at Trinity school every morning from the 5th – 8th May.

**In geography our topic is Kenya.**

We will learn about the location of Kenya and how this can affect the climate in different parts of the country. We will also study and compare living conditions in different parts of Kenya, and how these are affected by the local geography and climate.



**In Computing our topic is Selection in Physical Computing.**

- We will learn about writing and testing algorithms.

**In Music our topic is 'South and West Africa'**

We will be learning 'Shosholozza', a traditional South African song, playing the accompanying chords using tuned percussion and learning to play the djembe and some dance moves.

**In Latin (KS2) our topic is Off to Town**

- We will learn about Roman towns like York, Roman trade and how the Romans changed life in Britain.
