






## Quest Primary School Trips and Excursions

### Year 6 - Overview for Parents & Carers

	<p>Where: <b>Sayers Croft (Residential trip)</b> When: <b>Autumn Term 1</b></p> <p>Residential trip – Children will develop team building and problem-solving skills. They will also gain independence ahead of their transition to secondary school. The children will be taking part in many well-organised and challenging activities such as climbing, high ropes courses, caving, pond diving and orienteering.</p>		<p>Where: <b>The British Library</b> When: <b>Summer Term 1</b></p> <p>The children will be visiting the British library as part of our reading for pleasure focus in school along with developing thinking and questioning and research skills.</p> <p>At the library, they will have a tour of the different rooms and take part in one of the workshops. Back at school, we will reflect on how the British Library is different to our local library and what skills we learnt.</p>
	<p>Where: <b>Citizenship Trip</b> When: <b>Spring Term 1</b></p> <p>The children will be visiting Croydon Fire Station where they will learn about how to be a good citizen, in preparation for their transition to their new schools. The children have workshops on many topics, including travelling safely and keeping safe when out and about on their own.</p>		<p>Where: <b>The River Thames</b> When: <b>Summer Term 2</b></p> <p>The children will be visiting the Thames as part of their geography topic on London.</p> <p>Children will be walking alongside the Thames, following its route and learning about its history and importance to London. Children will learn about how the introduction of sewage systems impacted the river and its role during WW2. We will also be investigating how the river is used today.</p>
	<p>Where: <b>The Imperial War Museum</b> When: <b>Spring Term 1</b></p> <p>The children will be visiting the Imperial War Museum as part of their history topic on the role of the Croydon Airport during the Second World War. At the museum, children will be finding out about the Battle of Britain and what life was like for people living in London during World War 2.</p>
